CWLP Offering Appliance Rebate

For a limited time, City Water, Light and Power is offering its residential electric customers a mail-in rebate on the purchase of a new ENERGY STAR® qualified refrigerator, dishwasher or dehumidifier. Rebate amounts are \$400 for a qualifying refrigerator, \$200 for a qualifying dishwasher and \$100 for a qualifying dehumidifier. A limited number of rebates are being allocated to participating retailers. Purchases must be made between March 7 through March 13, 2011. Each customer may receive one of each type of rebate per billing address while available.

CWLP customers may pick up a rebate application from participating locations at the time of purchasing appliances. Only original applications will be accepted. Applications must be completed and submitted to the CWLP Energy Services Office within 30 days of purchase and postmarked no later than April 12, 2011. All applications must be accompanied with a detailed sales receipt or invoice that includes the manufacturer, model number and purchase price of the qualifying appliance, as well as the date purchased.

Purchases must be made between March 7 through March 13, 2011 from participating vendors with rebate applications available, which includes Aaron's, Best Buy, Dick Van Dyke Appliance World, Hampton's Kitchens & Appliances, Henry's, Lowe's (2 locations), Menard's (2 locations), Sam's Best Brands Plus, Sears and Vaughn's Appliance, Inc. (see list next page).

Customers who choose to recycle their pre-1993 refrigerator through CWLP's Refrigerator Roundup Program may be eligible for an additional \$50 rebate.
