BOIL ORDER ISSUED TO VAL-E-VUE SUBDIVISION

The City Water, Light & Power Water Department has issued a boil order to all residents of the Val-E-Vue Subdivision. This order follows emergency water main repairs that occurred on Saturday on Palomino Road. The water main was repaired, flushed and samples were taken for testing per Illinois Environmental Protection Agency regulations. One of the samples tested did not meet CWLP's preferred standards for water quality so this boil order is being issued while additional sampling and testing is complete. Once all new samples are tested and confirmed to meet CWLP's preferred water quality standards this boil order will be lifted.

This boil order will be in effect until at least this Wednesday when the next set of results will be read. Under a boil order it is recommended that all tap water used for drinking and cooking be brought to a rolling boil for five minutes and then cooled before use when appropriate.

Due to multiple recent main breaks to this area, the CWLP Water Department is working on plans for further water distribution system improvements to alleviate this problem area.
