BOIL ORDER LIFTED FOR VAL-E-VUE RESIDENTS, SYSTEM UPGRADES IN PROGRESS

On Sunday morning, July 18, at 8:30 a.m., City Water, Light & Power Water lifted the boil order for residents of the Val-E-Vue Subdivision. Normal water use for drinking and cooking may resume. This boil order, which began Friday morning, followed emergency water main repairs that occurred Thursday night on Palomino Road.

This week work will begin to reinforce the water main that serves the area from the east by adding a secondary connection at Bruns Lane. This work is expected to last about 10 days. The Water Department will also be looking at the possibility of replacing or adding another section of main along Palomino Road if additional breaks continue to occur.

There have been six water main breaks in this area since April on a section of main that has deteriorated west of Veteran's Parkway along Palomino Road. Over the course of this emergency work, 90 feet of pipe has been replaced, an old main has been abandoned and new valves have been added to limit the number of customers affected when outages do occur due to breaks. There are approximately 158 customers in the Val-E-Vue area.
