LONG BAY DRIVE TO GET LONG-NEEDED REPAIRS

Mayor Tim Davlin announced today that City Water, Light and Power General Manager Todd Renfrow and Public Works Director Mike Norris have come to a temporary solution to repair deteriorating Long Bay Drive. CWLP is hiring Public Works to implement a primer and asphalt application to the road, which has become increasingly treacherous in the last couple of years. Long Bay Drive is located in the Center Park area at Lake Springfield and is under CWLP's jurisdiction.

"Long Bay Drive is right up there at the top probably as the City road in the worst condition," said Mayor Davlin. "Anyone who has driven on it knows well, unfortunately, why this road is a top priority."

Long Bay Drive replacement work was part of CWLP's capital project requests in Fiscal Year 2008 along with the Pump Station improvements, which were cut out of the budget by the City Council. The total estimated cost for Long Bay Drive replacement was \$500,000.

Long Bay Road work will include nearly a mile of roadway in the Center Park area.
