Dear Mr. Breen,

City of Springfield, Office of Public Utilities (City Water, Light & Power or CWLP) submitted a demonstration for the Dallman Power Station and the Water Purification Plant to continue using the Lakeside ash pond and Dallman ash pond until October 13, 2023 pursuant to the alternative closure provision of 40 CFR 257.103(f)(1). All remaining construction and permitting activities have been completed and CWLP has ceased receipt of coal combustion residual (CCR) and non-coal combustion residual materials at the Lakeside ash pond and Dallman ash pond as of October 13, 2023. This notification is to inform the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that CWLP no longer needs an extension and is withdrawing the Part A Demonstration submitted for the facility under 40 CFR 257.103(f)(1).
